11	AMENDING TABLE 50, PAGE 45 OF THE IMPACT FEE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS
12	PLAN AND LAND USE ASSUMPTIONS, 2007-2012 TO INCLUDE EIGHT LIFEPAK
13	15'S, FOR TRANSMITTING CARDIAC PATIENT DATA, AS PLANNED FIRE/EMS
14	IMPROVEMENTS.

16	WHEREAS, on January 9, 2008, the Governing Body approved Resolution No. 2008-07
17	adopting the Impact Fee Capital Improvements Plan and Land Use Assumptions, 2007-2012 for
18	the city of Santa Fe; and
19	WHEREAS, the plan includes Table 50 entitled "Planned Fire/EMS Improvements, 2007-
20	2012"; and
21	WHEREAS, Section 14-8.14(G)(4)(a) SFCC 1987 in accordance with the New Mexico
22	Development Fees Act (5-8-1 NMSA) allows the use of impact fees to acquire capital
23	improvements including essential equipment costing \$10,000 or more and having a life
24	expectancy of ten-years or more; and
25	WHEREAS, if new equipment known as Lifepak 15 were available to the Santa Fe Fire

1	Department's emergency services, cardiac data from a cardiac patient could be directly
2	transmitted to the Cath Lab-Cardiac Unit at Christus St. Vincent Regional Medical Center where
3	it could be determined if the patient needs to be transported directly into surgery thus saving
4	thirty valuable life-saving minutes; and
5	WHEREAS, Christus St. Vincent Regional Medical Center and Christus St. Vincent
6	Foundation have each agreed to pay 33.3% of the cost of eight new Lifepak 15's and are requesting
7	that the city of Santa Fe pay the remaining approximately 33.3% (\$78,291 of \$240,000 total); and
8	WHEREAS the purchase of the eight Lifepak 15's is an eligible use of the city's impact fees.
9	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
10	CITY OF SANTA FE that Table 50, page 45 of the Impact Fee Capital Improvements Plan and
11	Land Use Assumptions, 2007-2012 is amended to include eight Lifepak 15's, for transmitting
12	cardiac patient data, as planned Fire/EMS improvements.
