

11 **TO CO-SPONSOR A FORUM WITH THE SANTA FE BOARD OF COUNTY**
12 **COMMISSIONERS, THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE SANTA FE COMMUNITY**
13 **COLLEGE AND THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE SANTA FE PUBLIC**
14 **SCHOOLS FOR THE PURPOSE OF SHARING INFORMATION AND DISCUSSING**
15 **PRIORITIES AND EMERGING ISSUES.**

17 **WHEREAS**, it would be beneficial for the Governing Body of the City of Santa Fe, the
18 Santa Fe Board of County Commissioners, the Governing Board of the Santa Fe Community
19 College and the Board of Education of the Santa Fe Public Schools to inform each other of policy
20 priorities and discuss ways to support each other's priorities as policy makers.

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**
22 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that the Governing Body agrees to co-sponsor and proceed with plans for
23 a forum, on an agreeable date, in order to: meet and share information; discuss priorities and
24 emerging issues; and coordinate, where possible, policy implementation with the Santa Fe Board
25 of County Commissioners, the Governing Board of the Santa Fe Community College and the


1 Board of Education of the Santa Fe Public Schools.

2 **AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the city manager is directed to:

3 1. Provide information for the forum regarding all agreements, resolutions
4 and ordinances relating to current policies and issues between the city and the other
5 governmental bodies.


6 2. Schedule a time, before the intergovernmental forum, at which the


