21	& Girls Club for 27 years; and
22	WHEREAS, Louis Montaño passed away in July of 2008; and
23	WHEREAS, Louis Montaño served as a Santa Fe City Councilor from 1974 to 1982, and
24	as Mayor of our great City from 1982 to 1986; and
25	WHEREAS, Louis Montaño was known to use his paycheck from the Santa Fe Boys &

1	Girls Club to buy groceries for the people who lived on Alto Street; and
2	WHEREAS, Louis Montaño was involved with our community his whole life.

5	leadership as director of the Boys & Girls Club, as a City Councilor and as Mayor, and as a

7	Alto Street across from the Boys & Girls Club "Louis Montaño" Park.
