11 **NAMING THE PARK LOCATED ON ALTO STREET ACROSS FROM THE BOYS &**
12 **GIRLS CLUB "LOUIS MONTAÑO" PARK.**

14 **WHEREAS**, the Governing Body adopted Resolution No. 2010-19 reestablishing the
15 procedures and criteria for naming city owned public spaces; and

16 **WHEREAS**, the park located on Alto Street across from the Boys & Girls Club was
17 deeded to the city by the Santa Fe Boy's Club in 1980; and

18 **WHEREAS**, the Boys & Girls Clubs of Santa Fe is the oldest provider of youth services
19 in Santa Fe; and

20 **WHEREAS**, Louis Montañó was a longtime Santa Fe resident and director of the Boys
21 & Girls Club for 27 years; and

22 **WHEREAS**, Louis Montañó passed away in July of 2008; and

23 **WHEREAS**, Louis Montañó served as a Santa Fe City Councilor from 1974 to 1982, and
24 as Mayor of our great City from 1982 to 1986; and


25 **WHEREAS**, Louis Montañó was known to use his paycheck from the Santa Fe Boys &

1 Girls Club to buy groceries for the people who lived on Alto Street; and

2 **WHEREAS**, Louis Montañó was involved with our community his whole life.


3 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**

8 PASSED, APPROVED, and ADOPTED this 28th day of April, 2010.


