13 **FOR THE ACEQUIA TRAIL AND TRAIL CROSSING AT ST. FRANCIS DRIVE.**



15 **WHEREAS**, the City of Santa Fe has made many efforts over the years to fund and build
16 pedestrian and bicycle trails in the community in order to encourage recreation and physical
17 fitness as well as alternate transportation; and

18 **WHEREAS**, the City has additional trail related efforts including, but not limited to:
19 creating the Bicycle and Trails Advisory Committee; facilitating bicycle connections for
20 Railrunner passengers at the Railyard; participating in Bike to Work Week; installing sharrows
21 aimed to help bicycles and cars share city streets; amending City street standards to require bike
22 lanes; conducting the bicycle safety poster contest for kids; participating in the Santa Fe
23 Metropolitan Planning Organization's bicycle and pedestrian study group whose vision is to
24 designate a network of regionally significant/primary trail corridors and connections; and
25 installing bike racks on city buses; and requiring bike racks for new development; and
