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8	WHEREAS, the City identified construction and operation of the upgrade and
19	improvements to the Santa Fe Water Treatment Facility Project; and
20	WHEREAS, the City has identified a need for financial assistance in order to
21	complete the upgrade and improvements to the Santa Fe Water Treatment Facility
22	Project; and
23	WHEREAS, the City is a qualified entity and the Governing Body is authorized
24	to borrow funds and/or issue bonds and/or receive financial assistance (e.g., grants) for
25	financing public projects for the benefit of the City and its citizens: and

WHEREAS, the Agreement prescribed by the New Mexico Environment

Department (NMED) has been completed and submitted to the Governing Body and this
resolution approving submission of the completed Agreement to the NMED for its
consideration and review is required as part of the Agreement process.

WHEREAS, a public meeting of the Governing Body of the City was held for the purpose of authorizing and approving submission of an executed agreement to the NMED for financial assistance in the form of a grant in the amount of \$700,000 for the upgrade and improvements to the Santa Fe Water Treatment Facility Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE that:

- Section 1. All action heretofore taken by the Governing Body and the officers and employees thereof directed toward the Agreement and the Project is hereby ratified, approved, and confirmed.
- Section 2. The completed and executed Agreement submitted to the Governing Body is hereby approved and confirmed.
- Section 3. The officers and employees of the Governing Body are hereby directed and requested to submit the completed Agreement to the Construction Programs Bureau of the NMED for its review and are further authorized to take such other action as may be requested by the NMED in its consideration and review of the Agreement and to further proceed with arrangements for providing grant financing to the Project.
- Section 4. The Governing Body adopts and passes this resolution authorizing the Mayor to sign the Agreement for this grant and appointing the City Manager and/or the Public Utilities Director or the Water Division Director as the GRANTEE REPRESENTATIVE(S) authorized to submit any documents pertaining to the project and act as the point(s) of contact.

1	Section 5. This resolution authorizes the City Manager and the Water Division
2	Director, or the Project Engineer, as the SIGNATORY AUTHORITY (S) authorized to
3	sign reimbursement requests and other documents requiring a signature for submittal to
4	the New Mexico Environment Department.
