1 CITY OF SANTA FE, NEW MEXICO 2 **RESOLUTION NO. 2010-43** 3 4 Councilor Wurzburger 5 6 7 8 9 10 A RESOLUTION 11 SUSPENDING THE ENFORCEMENT OF THOSE SECTIONS OF CHAPTER 7 AND 12 CHAPTER 14 SFCC 1987 SETTING FORTH THE EXPIRATION OF BUILDING 13 PERMITS AND DEVELOPMENT APPROVALS DUE TO SEVERE ECONOMIC 14 CONDITIONS. 15 16 WHEREAS, Chapter 7 SFCC 1987 and adopted building codes establish the expiration 17 of various types of building permits; and 18 WHEREAS, Chapter 14 SFCC 1987 and related policies and procedures establish 19 various time limits for development approvals such as master plans, general plan amendments, 20 rezonings, special exceptions, waivers, subdivision plats, development plans, variances, 21 archeological review committee clearances and historic design review board approvals; and 22 WHEREAS, Chapter 14 requires the applicant to apply for extensions of these approvals 23 should the applicant not meet the time limits; and 24 WHEREAS, the national, state and local economies have experienced a severe downturn 25 since 2008 and there is no clear immediate economic recovery in sight; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body desires to exercise its authority set forth in Section 14-2.2(A)(4) SFCC 1987 to temporarily suspend the enforcement of those sections of Chapter 7 setting forth the expiration of building permits and those sections of Chapter 14 SFCC setting forth the expiration of development approvals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE that:

- 1. The enforcement of those sections of Chapter 7, adopted building codes, and related policies and procedures that set forth the expiration of building permits is suspended as set forth in this paragraph. Upon adoption of this resolution, the expiration date of building permits set to expire on July 1, 2009 through the termination date of this resolution shall be tolled for a period of two years. This suspension shall apply only to those building permits where construction has not yet commenced.
- 2. The enforcement of those sections of Chapter14 SFCC and related policies and procedures that set forth the expiration of development approvals such as master plans, general plan amendments, rezonings, special exceptions, waivers, subdivision plats, development plans, variances, archeological review committee clearances, historic design review board approvals, and EZC/EZA approvals as described in the Santa Fe Extraterritorial Land Use Authority Subdivision, Planning, Platting and Zoning Ordinance (SPPaZO) (Extra Territorial Zoning Authority Ordinance No. 2009-1) is suspended as set forth in this paragraph. Upon adoption of this resolution, the expiration date of development approvals set to expire on July 1, 2009 through the termination date of this resolution shall be tolled for a period of two years.
- 3. This resolution shall automatically terminate on July 1, 2011. All building permits set to expire after the termination date shall expire in accordance with the requirements of the City of Santa Fe code in effect at the time of their issuance. All development approvals set to expire after the termination date shall expire in accordance with the requirements of the City of

1	Santa Fe code in effect at the time of their approval.
2	4. The applicant shall be responsible for being aware of the new time limits.
3	AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governing Body may consider the
4	extension of this resolution should the severe economic situation continue.
