10 **A RESOLUTION**

11 **APPEALING TO THE ALL INDIAN PUEBLO COUNCIL TO SAVE THE PAOLO**
12 **SOLERI AMPHITHEATER LOCATED ON THE SANTA FE INDIAN SCHOOL**
13 **CAMPUS.**

15 **WHEREAS**, the Paolo Soleri Amphitheater, located on the Santa Fe Indian School campus
16 and operated by the All Indian Pueblo Council, was intended for use by the Institute of American
17 Indian Arts and has served as the annual graduation site for the Santa Fe Indian School; and

18 **WHEREAS**, the Paolo Soleri Amphitheater is a local icon because of its unique
19 architecture and is a well known venue for musical performances; and

20 **WHEREAS**, the Paolo Soleri Amphitheater, completed in 1965 of earth-cast concrete,
21 was designed by Paolo Soleri, an Italian architect known as a founder of the green-building
22 movement; and

23 **WHEREAS**, there have been rumors circulating in the community that the Santa Fe
24 Indian School plans to shut down or even demolish the amphitheater; and

25 **WHEREAS**, the Governing Body recognizes the importance of the Paolo Soleri

1 Amphitheater to the community and wishes to join in the effort to save the amphitheater.


2 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**
3 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that the Governing Body appeals to the All Indian Pueblo Council to save
4 the Paolo Soleri Amphitheater.

5 **AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the city clerk is directed to submit a copy of
6 this resolution and a copy of Ordinance No. 2009-54 to the All Indian Pueblo Council.

7 **AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the city manager and the city attorney shall
8 communicate to the All Indian Pueblo Council that any action taken by a former city manager
9 purporting to allocate water rights to this property was, and is, null and void and ultra vires.


10 **AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the city manager shall report back to the
