10	A RESOLUTION
11	DIRECTING FINANCE STAFF TO EVALUATE AVAILABLE OPTIONS FOR THE
12	ONGOING FINANCING OF PARKS, OPEN SPACE, TRAILS AND RECREATIONAL
13	FACILITY PROJECTS.
14	
15	WHEREAS, the city of Santa Fe maintains 1,212 acres of developed parkland which
16	includes medians, arterial landscapes and walkways, and conservation easements; and
17	WHEREAS, this includes Neighborhood Parks, Regional Parks, Community Parks,
18	Pocket Parks, Open Space Parks, and Special Use Parks which together constitute the
19	approximately 59 parks and recreational facilities as well as the municipal golf course
20	maintained by the Parks Division; and
21	WHEREAS, there are approximately 5,938 acres of undeveloped parkland; and
22	WHEREAS, the city of Santa Fe maintains approximately 102 miles of trails; and
23	WHEREAS, the city of Santa Fe is charged with maintaining these parks, trails, and
24	open spaces, and other similar facilities that may be acquired or developed in the future, in a
25	manner that protects the health, safety, and welfare of all those who use these facilities; and

1	WHEREAS, the governing body passed Resolution No. 2001-80 adopting the City of
2	Santa Fe Parks, Open Space, Trails, and Recreation Master Plan; and
3	WHEREAS, the governing body recognizes that significant resources are needed to
4	implement the Parks, Open Space, Trails, and Recreation Master Plan; and
5	WHEREAS, the Parks Division has developed, through strategic planning, a plan that
6	will insure that the parks, trails, and other open spaces will receive adequate care and
7	maintenance; and
8	WHEREAS, Section 3-30-5 NMSA 1978 allows the issuance of bonds for the purpose of
9	securing funds for the building, beautifying and improving of public parks and for acquiring land
10	or buildings for playgrounds, recreation centers and other recreational purposes and the
11	equipment thereof; and
12	WHEREAS, on March 4, 2008, city of Santa Fe voters approved the issuance of general
13	obligation recreational purpose bonds up to \$30,300,000 to acquire land for, and to improve,
14	public parks, trails and open space for recreational purposes; and
15	WHEREAS, as of May 2010, the city has completed various projects and spent \$8.5M of
16	the general obligation bond on park and facility improvements; staff anticipates the completion of
17	the facility improvements by the end of 2010 and the park improvements by the fall of 2011; and
18	staff anticipates the first trail expenditures in the beginning of fiscal year 2010/11; and
19	WHEREAS, the Governing Body desires to continue building, beautifying and
20	improving city parks, trails and open space and recognizes the need to secure future funding; and
21	WHEREAS, future funding is also necessary for securing permanent park maintenance
22	workers and workforce training for the continuing maintenance of parks and trails improvements.
23	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
24	CITY OF SANTA FE that Finance staff is directed to evaluate available options for the ongoing
25	financing of parks, open space, trail and recreational facility projects.

1	AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Finance staff shall report back to the
2	Governing Body through the Parks and Open Space Advisory Commission, Bicycle and Trails
3	Advisory Committee, Public Works Committee and the Finance Committee within 60 days of the
4	adoption of this resolution.
