10 **A RESOLUTION**

11 **DECLARING, THIS YEAR AND EVERY YEAR THEREAFTER, THAT THE WEEK**  
12 **PRECEDING THE SANTA FE INTERNATIONAL FOLK ART MARKET SHALL BE**  
13 **KNOWN AS “INTERNATIONAL FOLK ARTS WEEK.”**

14  
15 **WHEREAS**, the Santa Fe International Folk Art Market (“the Market”) is the largest folk art  
16 market in the world; and

17 **WHEREAS**, owing to the influence of the Museum of International Folk Art and the success  
18 of the Market, Santa Fe in 2005 was designated as a UNESCO Creative City of Crafts and Folk Art;  
19 and

20 **WHEREAS**, UNESCO, the United Nations agency that promotes culture worldwide has  
21 been a sponsor of the Market since 2004; and

22 **WHEREAS**, the Market, now in its 7<sup>th</sup> year, will feature over 160 folk artists from more  
23 than 50 countries; enhancing Santa Fe’s image as a city with a global perspective; and

24 **WHEREAS**, the Market is a festive, colorful, and grassroots event that attracts more than  
25 23,000 visitors with a positive economic impact of over \$15 million in our community; and

1           **WHEREAS**, more than 1500 Santa Feans contribute their time and talent to make the  
2 Market a success and to welcome their international neighbors; and

3           **WHEREAS**, the Museum of International Folk Art and the Market together not only  
4 increase public awareness of world folk art traditions, but help to preserve and promote these  
5 community traditions; and

6           **WHEREAS**, the Museum of International Folk Art and the Market have partnered with  
7 Santa Fe businesses and other organizations to create a full week of events meant to educate and  
8 inspire visitors and citizens alike; and

9           **WHEREAS**, such events include ancillary activities such as exhibitions and gallery  
10 openings, a colloquium, lectures and gallery talks, a day camp, youth outreach, educational programs,  
11 demonstrations and book signings; and

12           **WHEREAS**, collaborative program planning for the Market continues to take place and will  
13 grow in coming years.


14           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**  
15 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that the Governing Body declares, this year and every year thereafter, that the  
16 week preceding the Santa Fe International Folk Art Market shall be known as "International Folk
