**A JOINT RESOLUTION**

**DIRECTING CITY STAFF AND SANTA FE PUBLIC SCHOOL STAFF TO WORK TOGETHER TO DESIGN AND IMPLEMENT A RECYCLING PROGRAM FOR THE SANTA FE PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT.**

**WHEREAS**, the City is committed to expanding its recycling efforts; and

**WHEREAS**, the Santa Fe Public School District (“District”) and the City recognize the educational benefit of instilling the principle of recycling in our youth; and

**WHEREAS**, several school districts, nationwide, have implemented recycling programs within their public schools; and

**WHEREAS**, currently a minimum number of schools in the District have recycling containers that are issued through Santa Fe Beautiful; and

**WHEREAS**, the efforts of a few schools is not enough to reduce the amount of potentially recyclable material that is disposed of as trash; and

**WHEREAS**, a great deal of waste generated from the District that is not recycled, ultimately ends up in the landfill; and

1           **WHEREAS**, the Santa Fe Board of Education recognizes the need to recycle materials,  
2 including paper, plastics, cardboard, metals and electronic waste used by all Santa Fe Public  
3 Schools; and

4           **WHEREAS**, both the City and the District recognize the value and importance of  
5 recycling; and

6           **WHEREAS**, the City and the District have committed to cooperate in areas of mutual  
7 benefit; and

8           **WHEREAS**, the support of the City is necessary to promote efficient recycling in the  
9 District.


10           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**  
11 **CITY OF SANTA FE AND THE SANTA FE BOARD OF EDUCATION** that the Governing  
12 Body of the City of Santa Fe and the Santa Fe School Board of Education desire to establish a  
13 recycling program throughout the District and direct their respective staff to work together to  
14 design and implement such a program with the assistance of Santa Fe Beautiful and the Santa Fe  
15 Solid Waste Management Agency.


