19 WHEREAS, education is central to the economic vitality and quality of life for Santa Fe
20 residents; and

21 WHEREAS, Graduate New Mexico is a Governor’s initiative organized through the
22 Public Education Department with the purpose of encouraging partnerships between schools and
23 other community resources focused on academics, services, supports and opportunities for
24 improved student learning, stronger families and healthier communities; and

25 WHEREAS, Graduate New Mexico partnerships will improve student learning by

1 addressing the need of the whole student - physical, social and emotional as well as academic - by
2 creating conditions that enable every student to succeed; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Graduate New Mexico promotes family engagement with students and
4 schools by providing access to existing community services and opportunities that help families
5 become partners in their children's education; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Graduate New Mexico will help schools function more effectively because
7 parents, schools and community partners will work together to support learning; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Graduate New Mexico partnerships will play a vital role in community
9 building by improving community knowledge of school initiatives, increasing awareness and use
10 of community agencies and access to school facilities, and strengthening community pride and
11 engagement.

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**
13 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that the Governing Body supports the efforts of Graduate New Mexico.

14 **AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Governing Body acknowledges the
15 importance of collaborative partnerships between the City of Santa Fe, the Santa Fe Public
16 Schools, the County of Santa Fe, Graduate New Mexico and local non governmental
17 organizations in order to make high school graduation "Everybody's Business" and to enable
18 every student to succeed.




