10	A RESOLUTION
11	REQUESTING THAT THE SANTA FE COUNTY CLERK RECORD CONDOMINIUM
12	DECLARATIONS ONLY UPON RECEIPT OF WRITTEN VERIFICATION FROM THE
13	CITY THAT A CONDOMINIUM DECLARATION COMPLIES WITH LOCAL ZONING
14	ORDINANCES AND REGULATIONS.

16	WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Santa Fe acknowledges and appreciates
17	the important role of the Santa Fe County Clerk in recording properly reviewed and approved
18	subdivision plats, development plans, and other city documents; and
19	WHEREAS, the County Clerk, by the professional performance of her duties, ensures
20	the recordation of these city-approved documents that, through compliance with local zoning
21	ordinances and subdivision regulations, promote and protect the health, safety and welfare of the
22	citizens of Santa Fe; and
23	WHEREAS, New Mexico state law currently requires condominiums to comply with
24	local zoning ordinances and subdivision regulations (Section 47-7A-6 NMSA 1978); however,
25	condominium declarations are often recorded at the office of the County Clerk without the

knowledge, review, or approval of city zoning officials; and

WHEREAS, currently the County Clerk has no way of knowing whether the condominium declarations presented to her for recordation comply with local zoning ordinances and subdivision regulations as required by state law; and

WHEREAS, recordation of declarations that create condominiums that are in violation of the city's or county's zoning ordinances and subdivision regulations create condominiums that are in violation of state law (Section 47-7A-6 NMSA 1978); and

WHEREAS, the creation of illegal, non-conforming condominiums is a serious problem for neighborhoods and for unsuspecting home buyers, real estate agents, title insurance companies, and attorneys who are often unaware that a condominium is illegal or that future building permits and zoning approvals for these properties are prohibited due to their illegal non-conformities.

WHEREAS, all developments other than condominiums that are located within the city are required to comply with the city's zoning ordinances and subdivision regulations; and

WHEREAS, developments that propose the condominium form of ownership will not in any way be discriminated against by the requested actions of the County Clerk, but rather will be subject to the same city review and approval as are all other developments that require recordation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE that the Santa Fe County Clerk is respectfully requested to record only those condominium declarations that are accompanied by written verification from the City of Santa Fe Land Use Department that the condominium declaration complies with city zoning ordinances and subdivision regulations.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk is directed to deliver a copy of this Resolution to the Santa Fe County Clerk, the Board of County Commissioners, the County
