11	AMENDING THE CITY'S ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES FOR WATER DEMAND
12	OFFSET REQUIREMENTS TO INCLUDE A WATER LOAN TRANSFER PROGRAM.

14	WHEREAS, on 31 <sup>st</sup> day of March, 2010, the Governing Body adopted Resolution No.
15	2010-20 "Administrative Procedures for Water Demand Offset Requirements"; and
16	WHEREAS, the administrative procedures were adopted pursuant to Ordinance No.
17	2009-38 that established new requirements for development water budgets, the water rights
18	transfer program, the city's water budget and a new water conservation credit program; and
19	WHEREAS, the Governing Body desires to establish a Water Transfer Loan Program
20	authorizing a transfer of water from one location to another in which: the first location may retain
21	a similar use for 12 months; the city receives at least one year and up to the entire value of the
22	loan value of the water rights or credits transferred; and no double demand on the city's water
23	system occurs.
24	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
25	CITY OF SANTA FE that the city's Administrative Procedures for Water Demand Offset

Requirements are amended to include Section 6 as follows:

## 6.1 Water Loan Transfer Program

An existing water customer seeking to transfer its current water use to another location within the city may enter into an agreement with the city for a low-interest (three percent or less) loan with a term of ten years based upon the current value of water rights or water credits as appropriate. The existing water customer shall be required to make monthly payments on the loan. At the end of twelve months, city staff will determine if a similar water use has been established at the old location. If there is a similar use, the existing water customer shall continue to pay off the loan. If there is not a similar use at the old location, the water budget shall be transferred to the new location and the obligation to repay the balance of the loan shall terminate.
