

1 remain including, but not limited to: playgrounds in desperate need of repair; ADA issues to be solved;
2 archaeological/cultural surveys to be completed; additional alternative park amenities that the city has
3 schematic designs or construction documents for; and missed opportunities and needs not previously
4 addressed; and

5 **WHEREAS**, in addition, other specific projects or issues remain including: a large
6 neighborhood/regional park in Tierra Contenta the area of the city experiencing the most recent growth in
7 the number of families with children; prairie dog relocations; Salvador Perez and Ragle regional parks;
8 Riverside Park; the Rail Trail and other trail connections; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the city has an extensive library of documents and plans that need to be reviewed
10 for parks, trails, open space and recreational projects or portions of projects yet to be completed; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the governing body recognizes that significant resources are needed to further
12 implement the Parks, Open Space, Trails, and Recreation Master Plan; and

13 **WHEREAS**, on June 30, 2010, the Governing Body adopted Resolution No. 2010-53 directing
14 staff to evaluate available options for the ongoing financing of parks, open space, trails and recreational
15 facility projects; and

16 **WHEREAS**, the governing body must determine the priorities of remaining parks, open space,
17 trails and recreational facilities yet to be funded.

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY**
19 **OF SANTA FE that:**


20 1. The Public Works Department working with city staff, the Parks and Open Space
21 Advisory Commission, the Bicycle and Trails Advisory Committee, the Regional Planning Authority and
22 other appropriate city committees are directed to review the Parks, Open Space, Trails, and Recreation
23 Master Plan and other relevant plans and documents in order to evaluate and prioritize the remaining
24 unfunded or under funded parks, open space, trails and recreational facilities.

25 2. City staff shall prepare preliminary cost estimates for completing the projects and for

1 maintaining and operating these projects as well as existing facilities that are currently under funded.


2 3. Within nine months of adoption of this resolution, the recommended priorities from the
3 individual committees as well as staff and related cost estimates shall be forwarded to the Public Works
4 and Finance Committees and then to the Governing Body who shall finalize the priorities and identify
5 funding solutions.


