2	CITY OF SANTA FE that staff is directed to commission a scientifically-based study of what
3	might encourage people to use transit and the conditions under which transit would be most
4	useful. These conditions include, but are not limited to, cost, frequency, routes, availability, type
5	of vehicle, and response time.
6	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the comprehensive study shall include the transit
7	needs of youth, including without limitation, a youth route and low cost or no cost fares for using
8	City transit.
