22	WHEREAS, the service of veterans has been vital to the history of the nation, and the
23	sacrifices made by veterans and their families should not be forgotten; and
24	WHEREAS, the Santa Fe National Cemetery consists of 78.6 acres with over 28,000
25	graves most of which are marked by upright headstones; and

a national shrine, veterans and their families in Santa Fe have requested that only upright
headstones be installed at the Santa Fe National Cemetery; and

WHEREAS, on January 28, 2009, the Governing Body of the City of Santa Fe unanimously Resolution No. 2009-15 and on behalf of veterans and their families, the City of Santa Fe lly requested from New Mexico's Congressional Delegation, the U.S. Department of Veteran's nd the New Mexico Department of Veterans Services that the necessary steps be taken so that eadstones are installed in the Santa Fe National Cemetery; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Veteran's affairs have indicated that a memorandum of ading would be an acceptable mechanism to ensure the commitment that all headstones ure are in the upright position.

OW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE F SANTA FE that staff is directed to prepare a memorandum of understanding with the artment of Veteran's Affairs that would commit the U.S. Department of Veteran's install all future headstones at the Santa Fe National Cemetery in the upright position.
