10	A RESOLUTION
11	DIRECTING STAFF TO INITIATE A PETITION-METHOD ANNEXATION FOR
12	RUFINA STREET.

14	WHEREAS, on June 13, 2007 a resolution was introduced at the regular meeting of the
15	Governing Body directing staff to initiate a petition method annexation for Airport Road; and
16	WHEREAS, the Governing Body further desires to simultaneously annex those portions
17	of Rufina Street that are outside the city limits; and
18	WHEREAS, the city of Santa Fe is owner of the entire length of Rufina Street; and
19	WHEREAS, as the owner of Rufina Street, the city can initiate a petition-method
20	annexation of that property; and
21	WHEREAS, annexation requires contiguity between the area to be annexed and a
22	municipality; and
23	WHEREAS, the owners of many individual properties along Rufina Street wish to annex
24	into Santa Fe but are not contiguous to the city; and

WHEREAS, many of these properties are contiguous to Rufina Street itself and would be contiguous to the city if the city annexed Rufina Street; and

WHEREAS, owners of these properties often approach the city to provide water, sewer, and other services that the County of Santa Fe cannot or will not provide to properties in this area; and

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe then faces the dilemma of being asked to provide services to areas that do not contribute to the city financially through gross receipt taxes, property taxes, impact fees, or other means; and

WHEREAS, the only planning authority the city exerts over these areas is through its minority membership on the Extraterritorial Zoning Authority; and

WHEREAS, if the city is going to provide services to new development along Rufina Street, it should have the benefit of taxes and other revenues that will be generated by that development and the ability to independently plan and oversee such development.

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE that staff is directed to initiate petition-method annexation of those portions of Rufina Street east of South Meadows Road and West of Henry Lynch Road that are not within city limits but which are owned by the City of Santa Fe.
