


10 A RESOLUTION

11 ADOPTING AN INFRASTRUCTURE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PLAN (ICIP).

13 WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe, New Mexico, a New Mexico municipal corporation,
14 recognizes that the financing of public capital projects has become a major concern in New
15 Mexico and nationally; and

16 WHEREAS, in times of scarce resources, it is necessary to find new financing
17 mechanisms and maximize the use of existing resources; and

18 WHEREAS, systematic capital improvements planning is an effective tool for
19 communities to define their development needs, establish priorities and pursue concrete actions
20 and strategies to achieve necessary project development; and

21 WHEREAS, this process contributes to local and regional efforts in project identification
22 and selection in short and long-range capital planning efforts.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
24 CITY OF SANTA FE, NEW MEXICO that:

- 25 1. The City of Santa Fe has adopted the attached Infrastructure Capital

3 toward improving rational, long-range capital planning and budgeting for New Mexico's




