

10 A RESOLUTION

11 TO REVIEW THE DOWNTOWN VISION PLAN AND RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE
12 DOWNTOWN VISION PLAN STEERING COMMITTEE; TO EXPLORE POSSIBLE
13 OPTIONS FOR IMPLEMENTATION AND TO SET PRIORITIES.

15 WHEREAS, the draft Downtown Vision Plan contains ideas brought forward by
16 community members and Downtown Vision Plan Steering Committee members; and

17 WHEREAS, the Governing Body allocated funds for the preparation of a Downtown
18 Master Plan through Resolution 2002-66; and

19 WHEREAS, the Governing Body approved the consulting contract with the consulting
20 firm of Crandall Arambula to prepare a Downtown Vision Plan on August 10, 2005; and

21 WHEREAS, the plan has been developed and revised through a public process; and

22 WHEREAS, the Downtown Vision Plan Steering Committee, appointed by the
23 Governing Body, has reviewed the draft document and made recommendations for revision; and

24 WHEREAS, on April 11, 2007, the Governing Body heard a presentation of the draft
25 Downtown Vision Plan presented by the Downtown Vision Plan Steering Committee and city

1 staff.

2 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**
3 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that:

4 1. The Downtown Vision Plan, included as "Exhibit A" attached hereto shall be
5 reviewed by staff (Downtown Vision Plan Steering Committee recommendations are included).

6 2. Implementation teams shall be established in order to explore possible
7 implementation steps and set priorities.

8 3. All recommendations by any implementation team shall be reviewed through the
9 committee process for final approval by the Governing Body.

10 4. All meetings shall be noticed to and open to the public.




