20	to provide additional school security; and
21	WHEREAS, there may be other and better opportunities to incorporate housing for
22	police officers in school campuses that will help provide a positive environment for our schools
23	and much needed housing for police officers.
24	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
25	CITY OF SANTA FE AND THE SANTA FE BOARD OF EDUCATION that:

2	community development department (or their designees) shall meet with the superintendent of
3	public schools (or her designee) to initiate a discussion regarding housing for police officers on
4	school property including existing and planned elementary, middle and high schools.
5	2. Staff shall identify obstacles, opportunities and possible implementation steps
6	and shall prepare a recommendation to the governing body and the board of education for their
7	consideration and approval within 30 days of passage of this resolution. Staff shall ultimately
8	determine whether there is a desire to pursue this concept.
