22	WHERAS, Resolution No. 2007-33 directed staff to draft a bill that would repeal the
23	IPM Board out of the IPM ordinance because the IPM board is inactive.
24	NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
.5	CITY OF SANTA FE that Resolution No. 2004-74 is repealed because an IPM board was not
