11 REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 2004-74 REGARDING THE INTEGRATED PEST
12 MANAGEMENT BOARD.

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14 WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2004-74 was adopted on September 29, 2004; and

15 WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2004-74 directed staff to submit a list of suggested
16 candidates for the Integrated Pest Management ("IPM") Board to the mayor no later than one
17 month after the adoption of Resolution No. 2004-74 so that the mayor could appoint members to
18 the IPM Board and have those appointments ratified by the governing body no later than three
19 weeks after the adoption of such resolution; and

20 WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2004-74 further directed staff to submit a "limited use list,"
21 as prescribed by the IPM ordinance, to the IPM Board at its first meeting; and

22 WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2007-33 directed staff to draft a bill that would repeal the
23 IPM Board out of the IPM ordinance because the IPM board is inactive.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
25 CITY OF SANTA FE that Resolution No. 2004-74 is repealed because an IPM board was not




