1	WHEREAS, the General Fian can's for the conadoration with the school District to
2	explore the implementation of developer impact fees as a means of ensuring sufficient
3	educational facilities; and
4	WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe recognizes the need to provide additional public library
5	facilities and services for children and adults in the Santa Fe community; and
6	WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe has developed an impact fee system that is specifically
7	designed to fund necessary capital facilities resulting from the impacts of community growth; and
8	WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe recognizes the need and desire for alternative funding
9	sources for capital outlays.
10	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
11	CITY OF SANTA FE that the Governing Body actively supports State legislation to amend the
12	Development Fees Act to include schools and libraries as eligible facilities within the Act.
13	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the School District is encouraged to adopt a
14	similar resolution in support of State legislation to amend the Development Fees Act to include
15	schools as an eligible facility within the Act.
16	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that staff is directed to forward a copy of this
17	resolution to the School District and the lobbyist for the City of Santa Fe.
