11	AUTHORIZING EIGHT (8) ARTS AND CRAFTS SHOWS AT CATHEDRAL PARK
12	DURING THE 2007 CALENDAR YEAR BECAUSE OF THE LIMITED AVAILABILITY
13	OF SPACE IN THE DOWNTOWN AREA DUE TO ON-GOING CONSTRUCTION.

15	WHEREAS, since 1988, the community has benefited from the annual arts and crafts
16	shows in Cathedral Park; and
17	WHEREAS, the Governing Body desires to continue its support of the arts in the
18	community as well as its consideration of property owners adjoining Cathedral Park; and
19	WHEREAS, through Resolution No. 2004-21, the Governing Body limited the number
20	of arts and crafts shows at Cathedral Park to a total of no more than six (6) per calendar year; and
21	WHEREAS, because of the current on-going construction in the downtown area, there is
22	limited space available for arts and crafts shows.
23	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
24	CITY OF SANTA FE that the Governing Body authorizes eight (8) arts and crafts shows at
25	Cathedral Park during the 2007 calendar year because of the limited availability of space in the

1	downtown area due to on-going constituction. One of the additional show dates shall be available
2	by consensus or lottery to one of the three non-profit arts organizations scheduled to hold arts and
3	crafts shows at Cathedral Park in 2007 and the other show date shall be available to the
4	Southwest Association of Indian Arts for Indian Market activities.
5	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that for the 2008 calendar year and every calendar
6	year thereafter, Cathedral Park shall be used six (6) times for arts and crafts shows, unless
7	otherwise resolved by the Governing Body.
