10 **A RESOLUTION**

11 **DIRECTING CITY STAFF TO DEVELOP AND PROMULGATE A COMPLETE LIST OF**  
12 **CITY MEETINGS.**

14 **WHEREAS**, the Governing Body wants to encourage public participation in all aspects  
15 of city government; and

16 **WHEREAS**, to this end, the city of Santa Fe holds numerous public meetings on a  
17 variety of issues; and

18 **WHEREAS**, while some of these meetings occur on a regular basis and are listed in the  
19 city's weekly meeting list, others occur less regularly or on an ad hoc basis; and


20 **WHEREAS**, those less formal meetings are not listed in the city's weekly meeting or in  
21 any other regularly published form; and

22 **WHEREAS**, public participation in these meetings will increase if information about  
23 them is available in a more accessible form.


24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**  
25 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that staff is directed to develop a mechanism through which information

1 about all public city meetings, formal or informal, is made available to the public in an easily  
2 accessible, timely, and widely disseminated manner, including publication and inclusion on the  
3 city's web site. Such a listing may be done in conjunction with, or separately, from, the format of  
4 the current weekly meeting list. Meetings to be listed include, but are not limited to, Early  
5 Neighborhood Notification meetings, public meetings about upcoming Public Works Department  
6 projects, city-sponsored roundtables, and other city-sponsored public meetings involving city  
7 staff or members of the governing body.


