13	AWARENESS CAMPAIGN AND TO EXAMINE PEDESTRIAN ROUTES TO BUS	
14	STOPS, IDENTIFY WHERE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS ARE REQUIRED TO	
15	FACILITATE SAFE ACCESS TO SUCH STOPS, PRIORITIZE NEEDED

20	WHEREAS, access to a facility is a primary requirement of the Americans with	
21	Disabilities Act (ADA); and	
22	WHEREAS, the city of Santa Fe is committed to encouraging alternative modes of	
23	transportation including riding the bus, bicycling and walking; and	
24	WHEREAS, safety awareness is an important component of advancing walking as a	
25	means of transportation for pedestrians and mobility disabled pedestrians alike; and	

1	WHEREAS, the majority of all bus riders start and end their trips as pedestrians and		
2	wish for these parts of their trips to be as safe as the part taken on the bus; and		
3	WHEREAS, safe and accessible sidewalks are not universally provided throughout		
. 4	neighborhoods and business districts within the city; and		
5	WHEREAS, such deficiencies are particularly problematic for those who choose to		
6	make use of the transit system for their transportation needs; and		
7	WHEREAS, the repair and maintenance of existing sidewalks is generally the		
8	responsibility of the adjacent property owner; and		
9	WHEREAS, the City Council has budgeted funds to address locations where gaps in the		
10	sidewalk network exist; and		
11	WHEREAS, the Transit Advisory Board has chosen to focus on this issue in order to		
12	improve access within 100 feet of bus stops to make the transit system more available and		
13	attractive to the public.		
14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Governing Body of the city of		
15	Santa Fe directs transit division staff to work with other public works department staff to develop		
16	and execute a pedestrian safety awareness campaign and to examine pedestrian routes to bus		
17	stops, identify where capital improvements are required to facilitate safe access to such stops,		
18	prioritize needed improvements in consultation with the transit advisory board, and recommend		
19	implementation of such improvements to the Governing Body such that needed improvements		
20	can be duly budgeted and constructed.
