A RESOLUTION
CREATING THE MAYOR'S CUP, TRAVELING TROPHY,
FOR HIGH SCHOOLS IN THE CITY OF SANTA FE.

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe is an advocate for sports and team spirit in our schools;
and

WHEREAS, athletic activities in our community begin in elementary school and
continue on through high school; and

WHEREAS, athletic activities have always been an excellent way to encourage youth to
learn sports, leadership and teamwork; and

WHEREAS, the excitement of competing with other schools is what makes athletic
activities high spirited and rewarding; and

WHEREAS, a city sponsored award for the City champion team in the various athletic
activities at the high school level of sports would be an honor for a school team to hold; and

WHEREAS, such award would be an encouragement for the team to improve their skills
and work towards another winning season.

3 1. Staff is hereby directed to implement the Mayor's Cup, Traveling Trophy

- 9 E. Varsity Boys Soccer
- 10 F. Varsity Boys Cross Country
- 11 G. Varsity Boys Golf
- 12 H. Varsity Boys Swim
- 13 I. Varsity Boys Tennis
- 14 J. Varsity Boys Track
- 15 K. Varsity Girls Basketball
- 16 L. Varsity Girls Volleyball
- 17 M. Varsity Girls Softball
- 18 N. Varsity Girls Soccer
- 19 O. Varsity Girls Golf
- 20 P. Varsity Girls Cross Country
- 21 Q. Varsity Girls Tennis
- 22 R. Varsity Girls Swim
- 23 S. Varsity Girls Track
- 24 T. Varsity Cheerleading

25 2. The Mayor's Cup will be given to the city champions who will be determined by


1 their record against other teams in their respected sport category.

2 3. The Mayor's Cup will remain at the winning school for a one year period until
3 the next season is complete and the champions are determined.


4 4. The Mayor's Cup will be returned to City Hall for engraving and presentation by
5 the governing body at a regularly scheduled meeting.


6 5. The Mayor's Cup traveling trophy program shall be in place and ready for
