

DIRECTING STAFF TO DEVELOP A COMPREHENSIVE TREE POLICY FOR THE CITY OF SANTA FE.

WHEREAS, trees can provide significant environmental benefits to a city, including moderating climate, improving air quality, conserving water, and harboring wildlife; and

WHEREAS, those benefits vary by tree species and placement of trees within the environment; and

WHEREAS, scientifically-oriented tree management can maximize the benefits achieved from trees and minimize any negative consequences associated with certain species or placements.

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE that staff is directed to develop a comprehensive tree policy for the city. This policy should include, but not be limited to:

1. Developing a plan to replace aging street trees and to plant street trees in areas that have been without them or where removed and that the plan make recommendations
