A RESOLUTION

AMENDING THE SANTA FE MUNICIPAL AIRPORT MASTER PLAN TO
INCORPORATE A NEW COMBINED TRAINING FACILITY FOR THE CITY OF
SANTA FE POLICE AND FIRE DEPARTMENTS, INCLUDING A SECURE VEHICLE
IMPOUND YARD.

WHEREAS, on July 10, 2002, the city of Santa Fe passed Resolution No. 2002-40
adopting the Santa Fe municipal airport master plan as presented by Coffman Associates Inc. in
association with Molzen-Corbin Associates; and

WHEREAS, the individual training facilities for both the city of Santa Fe police
department and fire department are long past their usable lives and should be replaced; and

WHEREAS, the city of Santa Fe has had prepared a master plan for a new combined
training facility for the police and fire departments, located at the remote southeast corner of the
airport, and a secure vehicle impound yard for the police department, located on the north side of
the airport along the access road to the national guard facility; and

WHEREAS, when the new training facility is not being used by the city police or fire

1 departments, the facility could be rented to other local law enforcement agencies such as the
2 county sheriff, the U.S. forestry department, the bureau of land management or the New Mexico
3 department of public safety thereby generating revenues for the city; and

4 **WHEREAS**, in order to maintain federal funding for the airport, the federal aviation
5 administration must review and approve projects constructed on airport property; and

6 **WHEREAS**, this federal funding requires that the airport be self sufficient and if airport
7 property is used for non-airport related purposes, the user must reimburse the airport fund.

8 **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**
9 **CITY OF SANTA FE that:**


10 Section 1. The Santa Fe municipal airport master plan is amended to incorporate the
11 facility master plan entitled "A New Combined Training Facility for the City of Santa Fe Police
12 Department and City of Santa Fe Fire Department", which includes a secure vehicle impound
13 yard, dated October 20, 2006 (CIP project #692).

14 Section 2. The city shall reimburse the airport fund for use of airport property
15 consistent with existing airport leases as determined by the airport manager and approved by the
16 governing body.

17 Section 3. Additional revenue generated by renting the training facility to outside
18 agencies is to be used to reimburse the airport fund.

19 Section 4. All users of these facilities shall comply with all airport security and
20 safety requirements, and federal rules and regulations pertaining to the Santa Fe Municipal
21 Airport.


