10 A RESOLUTION

11 SUPPORTING AND ADOPTING A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN LOS
12 ALAMOS COUNTY, THE NORTH CENTRAL REGIONAL TRANSIT DISTRICT, AND
13 PARTICIPATING REGIONAL PARTNERS FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF \$1.5
14 MILLION OF NEW GROSS RECEIPTS TAX RECEIVED BY LOS ALAMOS COUNTY.

16 WHEREAS, as a result of the new management paradigm at Los Alamos National
17 Laboratory, Los Alamos County has received new gross receipts revenues; and

18 WHEREAS, Los Alamos County is reaching out to other communities in Northern New
19 Mexico by offering to dedicate some of these new gross receipts for regional needs; and

20 WHEREAS, a cooperative agreement has been prepared as an initial means of sharing a
21 portion of this revenue; and

22 WHEREAS, the parties to this agreement wish to provide a mechanism for participation
23 in and resolution of regional issues arising from the change in the Lab contract; and

24 WHEREAS, transportation has been identified as a key regional issue impacting the
25 region's economy by moving goods, services, and employees and connecting communities in

1 Northern New Mexico; and

2 **WHEREAS**, for the purposes described above, the agreement proposes to allocate \$1.5
3 million from new gross receipts tax revenue received by Los Alamos County for the following:

4 North Central Regional Transit District	\$1,100,000 per year
5 Regional Economic Development Study	Not to exceed \$250,000 one time
6 Española Basin Regional Planning Issues Forum	Not to exceed \$150,000 per year

7 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE GOVERNING BODY OF**
8 **THE CITY OF SANTA FE** supports and adopts cooperative agreement between Los Alamos
9 County, the North Central Regional Transit District, and participating regional partners regarding
10 distribution of \$1.5 million of the gross receipts tax received by Los Alamos County resulting
11 from the new lab management contract at Los Alamos National Laboratory for the purposes of
12 providing a mechanism for participation in and resolution of regional issues arising from the
13 change in the Lab contract and expanding transportation options for affected communities in
14 Northern New Mexico.


