16	plan called Governor Richardson's Investment Partnership ("GRIP") to improve transportation

18	WHEREAS, the New Mexico Legislature approved the GRIP program in the same yea
19	and the Department of Transportation is implementing the GRIP projects; and
20	WHEREAS, while GRIP addresses critical transportation needs statewide, Governor
21	Richardson also recognizes the critical transportation needs of our local and tribal communities
22	by developing GRIP2; and
23	WHEREAS, Governor Richardson has called for a balanced approach that invests in
24	multiple transportation alternatives to produce a full service transportation network for all of our
25	citizens and visitors; and

1	WHEREAS, in order to meet the local transportation needs of our communities, GRIP2
2	proposes 110 Projects totaling \$250 Million; and
3	WHEREAS, GRIP2 contains a flexible matching program and assistance with project
4	development; and
5	WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe worked through the Santa Fe Metropolitan Planning
6	Organization transportation planning process to determine our community's most critical
7	transportation need; and
8	WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe supports GRIP2 because it provides funding for
9	continuing reconstruction of Cerrillos Road and the Siler Road Extension and Bridge project.
10	NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
11	CITY OF SANTA FE that the governing body endorses and supports passage of the GRIP2
12	legislation in the upcoming 2007 legislative session.
