17	Section 1. Section 23-1.4 SFCC 1987 (being Code 1953, § 24-4 – 24-7) is amended to

19	23-1.4 Obstruction of Streets.		
20	A. Permit Required: Fee. Except as otherwise provided, any person desiring to place		
21	any obstruction on any public street, alley or way in the city shall make application to the public		
22	works department for a permit to do so. Such permit shall be granted on compliance with terms as		
23	may be imposed by a city engineer and on the payment of a fee[s as may be required by the city] of		
24	one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per permit.		
25	B. Warning Lights Required. Except as otherwise provided, warning lights shall be		

placed and maintained from sundown to sunup of every day at both ends of every obstruction on any				
street of the city and at intervals of not more than fifty feet (50') along such obstruction.				
C.	C. Removal.			
	(1)	Any obstruction on any street or alley or in that half of the street adjoining		
any store, shop, building or premises in violation of paragraphs A. or B. above, shall				
immediately be removed by the owner or occupant of the premises.				
	(2)	It is the duty of any police officer or other authorized city employees finding		
an obstruction in any street or alley, to notify and require the owner, occupant or person in				
charge, to remove the obstruction immediately.				
	(3)	It is unlawful for any person to refuse or neglect to comply with such order		
and the city shall immediately remove the obstruction at the expense of the owner or				
00	ccupant.			
	(4)	No person shall hinder, interfere with, or prevent the city from performing		
any of the duties conferred in this paragraph.

separate permit shall be required for each street cut as defined in subsection 22-2.3 SFCC 1987. A				
single repair project may consist of multiple street cuts.				
E	3. Resto	ration penalties provided for in this section shall be [ten dollars (\$10.00)]		
twenty dollars (\$20.00) per square foot of resurfaced area.				
	C. After	acceptance or approval by the city of the work completed under the permit, a		
property owner residing on the property for which the work was completed may apply to the streets				

1	division for reimbursement of the fee provided that all dwelling units on the property are occupied by		
2	a household earning less than eighty percent (80%) of the area median income as certified by a		
3	nonprofit affordable housing organization, under contract with the city, or otherwise qualified
