

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10 AN ORDINANCE

11 AMENDING ARTICLE 23-6 SFCC 1987 TO PERMIT THE LIMITED SALE AND
12 CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT FORT MARCY BALL PARK FOR
13 PROFESSIONAL BASEBALL GAMES.

15 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE:

16 Section1. Article 23-6 SFCC 1987 (being Ord. #1981-39, §20, as amended) is
17 amended to read:

18 23-6 SALE OR CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; CITY PROPERTY.

19 A. The sale or consumption of alcoholic beverages on property owned or controlled by
20 the city shall be prohibited except as set forth in this Section 23-6.

21 B. The sale or consumption of alcoholic beverages is permitted at the following
22 locations:

23 (1) The Santa Fe community convention center and adjacent outdoor spaces
24 under the center's control;

25 (2) That area of the Santa Fe municipal airport main terminal building and

1 adjacent areas operated as a restaurant; and

2 (3) The Marty Sanchez Links de Santa Fe (golf course).

3 (4) The area of the Fort Marcy Ballpark designated as a beer garden that shall be
4 used for the sale and consumption of only beer and only at professional baseball games.

5 (a) For purposes of this sub-section, beer garden means an area of Fort
6 Marcy Ballpark with restricted entry and exit that shall be comprised of no more than
7 twenty five percent (25%) of the area designated for ballpark seating.

8 (b) The use of a privately owned or governmental liquor license is
9 required for such use.

10 (c) No person under the age of twenty-one (21) shall be permitted in the
11 beer garden.

12 (d) The determination of the actual location of the beer garden within the
13 ballpark, along with the requirements for the beer garden, including buffering and
14 public health and safety requirements, shall be adopted by separate resolution of the
15 governing body.

16 C. The sale or consumption of alcoholic beverages is permitted in buildings owned by
17 another party located on land owned by the city.


18 D. The sale or consumption of alcoholic beverages is permitted on land or buildings
19 owned by the city for which the city has entered into a lease with another party for six (6) months or
20 more except for the Railyard Park, Plaza and Alameda (as defined in the Deed of Conservation
21 Easement dated October 1, 2004) where alcohol is prohibited.

22 E. The sale or consumption of alcoholic beverages is permitted in or on railroad cars
23 located on railroad tracks except as prohibited by state or federal law.

24 F. All other applicable approvals required by state or city laws shall be obtained prior to
25 the sale or consumption of alcoholic beverages on the property described in this [~~Section~~] Article 23-6.
