AN ORDINANCE

AMENDING SECTION 23-8.5 SFCC 1987 TO REGULATE THE TYPES OF GOODS AND WARES STREET PERFORMERS MAY SELL; AND AMENDING SECTION 23-8.7 SFCC 1987 REGARDING CRIMINAL ENFORCEMENT, PENALTY; AND ADMINISTRATIVE ENFORCEMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE:

- Section 1. Section 23-8.5 SFCC 1987 (Ord. #2009-50, §6) is amended to read:
- 23-8.5 Regulations. Street performers may perform on public property within the city of Santa Fe [provided that they] but shall comply with the following regulations.
- A. Street performers shall not block, or cause the blocking of[5] any sidewalk, passageway, street, or entrance to a building.
- B. With the exception of audio recordings, video recordings, hand-made items or written materials that relate to their performance, a [S]street performer[s] shall not sell any other type of goods or wares on public property [other than goods or wares that directly relate to their performance].

2	(4) Any street performer who violates any provision of Article 23-8 SFCC
3	1987 or any other city ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished in accordance
4	with the provisions of Article 1-3 SFCC 1987.
5	[D. Upon conviction of a third violation in municipal court, the license shall be revoked
6	for one (1) year.]
7	B. Administrative Enformcement.
8	(1) If a street performer is in violation of any provision of this Article or any
9	provision of the SFCC 1987; or is operating in a manner contrary to the public welfare, then
0	the city finance director may, in his discretion and upon reasonable evidence:
1	(a) Send the street performer a notice of violation specifically stating:
12	(i) The nature of the violation;
13	(ii) Whether there are past due license fees; and
14	(iii) If there are past due license fees, order that the past due
15	license fees, plus a penalty that is double the amount due, be paid
6	immediately, upon receipt of the notice;
17	(iv) If the fee and penalty are not paid, the provisions of this
8	Article or other provisions of the SFCC 1987 are not complied with and the
9	operation contrary to the public welfare is not discontinued within fifteen
20	(15) days after receipt of the notice, the street performer shall surrender his
21	business license to the finance director and the license shall be placed in
22	suspension until a hearing is held before the finance committee for
23	consideration of revocation of the business license; or
24	(b) If the street performer's action creates an immediate and imminent
25	danger, immediately place the business license in suspension until a hearing is held

1	to the appellant at least five (5) calendar days prior to the meeting of the governing
2	body.
