11 **A RESOLUTION**

12 **URGING THE COMMUNITY TO SUPPORT THE SANTA FE VETERAN COMMUNITY**
13 **CENTER.**

14 **WHEREAS**, there are 12,000 veterans in Santa Fe County; 90,000 veterans in counties
15 surrounding Santa Fe County; and over 178,082 veterans throughout New Mexico; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Sanchez y Ortiz Foundation, a non-profit 501c3 organization, in
17 collaboration with local Santa Fe veterans and veteran associations, proposes to build the Santa
18 Fe Veteran Community Center (SFVCC), a one-of-a-kind community integration, health and
19 wellness center; and

20 **WHEREAS**, the SFVCC will give back a quality of life to our veterans by providing all
21 veterans with a community place of his or her own in an environmentally friendly (USGBC
22 LEED-Platinum) community center with ongoing, green collar workforce development and
23 entrepreneurial training; and

24 **WHEREAS**, the SFVCC will serve meals, house child daycare and sports facilities,
25 include a rehab lap pool and arts and media facilities, provide supportive services including


1 comprehensive mentoring, counseling, health and wellness alternatives and workforce training; and

2 **WHEREAS**, veterans will be the preferred choice for the on-site construction workforce,
3 consultants, service providers and managers of the facility; and

4 **WHEREAS**, the SFVCC will be designed and built in Phase Developments for a total
5 estimated 22,000 square foot of building space and estimated to be a \$6.8M project including the
6 land acquisition.


7 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**


