A RESOLUTION

WELCOMING THE IMBA SUBARU TRAIL CREW TO SANTA FE AS A PARTNER WITH THE SANTA FE FAT TIRE SOCIETY, THE TRAILS ALLIANCE OF SANTA FE AND THE CITY OF SANTA FE TO COMPLETE TRAIL PROJECT 10, A QUARTER MILE CONNECTING TRAIL IN LA TIERRA.

WHEREAS, the IMBA (International Mountain Bicycling Association) Subaru Trail
Crew, a professional trail building crew, will be coming to Santa Fe from May 5 through May 8,

2011; and

WHEREAS, in addition to a presentation on the economic benefits of trails, the visit will feature the main event on May 7th where activities will include a trail building class in the morning followed by a trail building project by the IMBA Subaru Trail Crew and members of the public in the afternoon; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Fe Fat Tire Society and the Trails Alliance of Santa Fe, organizers of the event, are requesting that the city authorize them to complete Trail Project 10, a quarter (0.25) mile connecting trail in the proposed La Tierra (NWQ) Trails master plan as the

vent's trail building project; and

WHEREAS, this volunteer effort could save \$10,000-\$20,000 in projected building costs or the La Tierra trails project and promote volunteerism by getting 30-50 volunteers actively nvolved with Trail Project 10; and

WHEREAS, although the La Tierra trails master plan is not yet approved and is currently going through an extensive public review process, the proposed trail building project is consistent with the proposed goals and objectives of the proposed trails master plan; and

WHEREAS, typically, the IMBA Subaru Trail Crew can complete from 500to 1,000 feet of trail in one afternoon, however, the Santa Fe Fat Tire Society and the Trails Alliance are committed to finishing the project as soon as possible; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Fe Fat Tire Society and the Trails Alliance of Santa Fe aim to make the event an opportunity to publicize the La Tierra trails as well as their local efforts to promote more volunteerism for maintaining the city's trails; and

WHEREAS, this joint project with the IMBA Subaru Trail Crew, the Santa Fe Fat Tire Society and the Trails Alliance of Santa Fe is another effort on behalf of the city of Santa Fe to achieve "Bicycle Friendly Community" status.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE that the IMBA Subaru Trails Crew is hereby welcomed to Santa Fe as a partner with the Santa Fe Fat Tire Society, the Trails Alliance of Santa Fe and the city of Santa Fe to complete Trail Project 10, a quarter mile connecting trail in La Tierra.
