

10 A RESOLUTION

11 ADOPTING APPLICATION FEES FOR THE REVIEW OF TELECOMMUNICATIONS  
12 FACILITIES IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 14 SFCC 1987.

14 WHEREAS, as per Section 14-3.1(D) SFCC 1987, the Governing Body establishes by  
15 resolution a schedule of fees for matters pertaining to Chapter 14 Land Development; and

16 WHEREAS, on May 25, 2011, the Governing Body adopted Ordinance No. 2011-16  
17 creating a new Section 14-6.2(E) SFCC 1987 regarding telecommunications facilities outside  
18 public rights-of-way.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE  
20 CITY OF SANTA FE that:

21 1. The following applications fees for the review of telecommunications facilities in  
22 accordance with 14-6.2(E) shall be adopted:

23 *Administrative Approval* \$500

24 *Planning Commission Review*

25 *Cost of Development*

17	Historic Design Review Board	\$25 each
18	Other	\$30 each

19       2.       Building permit fees and secondary permit fees shall apply as per Land Use  
20 Department fee schedules.

21       3.       If the Land Use Department determines that it is necessary to obtain the services  
22 of an outside party to assist the city in reviewing certain aspects of an application, the city may  
23 charge additional fees to cover the actual costs of the review.

24       4.       All fees are non-refundable.


25       5.       This resolution shall supersede any prior fee schedule established by the City for


