| 17 | WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe is a public body with the mission of promoting the health, |

| 20 | enhance mobility options for residents and visitors alike, but also to enhance commerce and safety; |

| 23 | the construction and operation of world class museum facilities along Camino Lejo, an area that has |
| 24 | come to be known as Museum Hill; and |
| 25 | WHEREAS, Museum Hill serves as the host to a number of special events, on an annual |

| 6 | Hill shuttle parking, Wheelwright Indian Market Auction and Rag Rug Festival, the Santa Fe |
| 7 | Botanical Garden Plant Sale, the Laboratory of Anthropology Book Sale, as well as exhibition |
| 8 | openings at all of the resident museums; and |
| 9 | WHEREAS, the State of New Mexico owns and maintains Camino Lejo, which serves as the |
| 10 | access route for vehicles and pedestrians who attend the events; and |
| 11 | WHEREAS, improvements to the south shoulder of Camino Lejo are critical to ensure the |
| 12 | safety of pedestrians who participate in special events on Museum Hill, as well as to allow |
| 13 | unconstrained emergency vehicle access. |
| 14 | NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE |
| 15 | CITY OF SANTA FE that to ensure the safety of pedestrians who attend special events at Museum |
| 16 | Hill and for unconstrained emergency vehicle access, the Governing Body hereby requests that the |
| 17 | State of New Mexico design, fund, and oversee construction of shoulder improvements to the south |
| 18 | side of Camino Lejo adjacent to the Museum Hill's main parking area. |
| 19 | BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that staff is directed to forward a copy of this resolution to |
| 20 | the State of New Mexico. |
