


10 A RESOLUTION

11 IN COLLABORATION WITH THE SANTA FE CONSERVATION TRUST AND SANTA FE  
12 COUNTY TO CONNECT THE DALE BALL NORTH TRAIL TO LITTLE TESUQUE  
13 CREEK AND SANTA FE COUNTY OPEN SPACE LANDS ("LA PIEDRA TRAIL").

15 WHEREAS, on September 13, 2011, Santa Fe County ("County") approved the purchase of  
16 54 acres of land, more or less, at the end of Brownell Howland Road from the Santa Fe Conservation  
17 Trust (the "Trust") to connect the Dale Ball Trail with the County's open space land along Little  
18 Tesuque Creek; and

19 WHEREAS, the Trust has agreed to construct the new trail connection, at no cost to the  
20 County Open Space Program; and

21 WHEREAS, the Trust has requested permission from the City to construct approximately  
22 700 feet of the new trail on City property to connect the new trail to the Dale Ball Trail and to allow  
23 construction crews to cross the City's land on foot during the construction of the La Piedra Trail; and

24 WHEREAS, there will be no cost to the City for the construction of the La Piedra Trail that  
25 will enhance non-motorized public recreation opportunities in the City; and
