| 11 | ADOPTING THE CITY OF SANTA FE UPDATED ADA TRANSITION PLAN AND |
| 12 | SELF EVALUATION. |
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| 14 | WHEREAS, the Americans with Disabilities Act, 42 U.S.C. 12101-12213 (ADA) was |
| 15 | enacted in 1990; and |
| 16 | WHEREAS, the ADA is landmark legislation that provides comprehensive civil rights |
| 17 | protection to individuals with disabilities in the areas of employment, public accommodations, |
| 18 | state and local government services and programs and telecommunications; and |
| 19 | WHEREAS, the ADA prohibits local governments from discriminating on the basis of |
| 20 | disability; and |
| 21 | . WHEREAS, in 1992, the City of Santa Fe prepared a Self Evaluation and Transition |
| 22 | Plan as required by Title II of the ADA, and |
| 23 | WHEREAS, in accordance with the Transition Plan, the City implemented regulations |
| 24 | that provided civil rights protections to individuals with disabilities in employment, public |
| 25 | accommodations and municipal services and programs; and |

| 1 | WHEREAS, additionally, the Transition Plan identified which modifications were |
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| 2 | needed at City facilities to make the facilities accessible for persons with disabilities and also |
| 3 | guided the implementation of the modifications; and |
| 4 | WHEREAS, the ADA mandates that every public entity re-evaluate its current |
| 5 | programs, services and policies to determine whether they are in compliance with Title II of the |
| 6 | ADA; and |
| 7 | WHEREAS, the City hired a consultant to update the City's ADA Transition Plan; and |
| 8 | WHEREAS, the consultant conducted barrier assessment surveys of City owned |
| 9 | buildings, parks and public rights-of-way that lead to City facilities; and |
| 10 | WHEREAS, the consultant conducted a self evaluation with City staff relating to the |
| 11 | needs of persons with disabilities in service situations at all City programs and services; and |
| 12 | WHEREAS, the ADA Transition Plan Update documents the steps taken by the City to |
| 13 | evaluate services and programs to ensure compliance with ADA requirements; and |
| 14 | WHEREAS, where it was determined that the City is not currently in compliance, the |
| 15 | Transition Plan Update outlines actions to be taken in order to bring City facilities, services and |
| 16 | programs into compliance as required by the ADA; and |
| 17 | WHEREAS, under Title II, a public entity may not deny the benefits of its programs, |
| 18 | services, and activities to individuals with disabilities by maintaining inaccessible facilities, |
| 19 | which house these programs, services and activities; and |
| 20 | WHEREAS, a public entity's programs, services, and activities, when viewed in their |
| 21 | entirety, must be made accessible to and usable by individuals with disabilities; and |
| 22 | WHEREAS, the Governing Body recognizes that the Mayor's Committee on Disability |
| 23 | generously gave their time and provided information to make the Transition Plan Update |
| 24 | possible. |
| 25 | NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE |

| 1 | CITY OF SANTA FE that the Governing Body hereby adopts the ADA Transition Plan Update |
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| 2 | ("2011 Transition Plan") by reference. |
| 3 | BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the 2011 Transition Plan shall be available for |
| 4 | public inspection in the City Clerk's Office, on the City's Website and in the office of the City's |
| 5 | ADA Coordinator. The Transition Plan Barrier Assessment Survey shall also be available for |
| 6 | inspection in the office of the ADA Coordinator. |
| 7 | BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the 2011 Transition Plan shall be implemented in |
| 8 | the following manner: |
| 9 | The 2011 Transition Plan shall be maintained and updated for the duration of the |
| 10 | Transition Planning period. |
| 11 | The 2011 Transition Plan is a working document that shall be modified as barriers |
| 12 | are removed or alterations are made. |
| 13 | City staff responsible for overseeing the barrier-removal projects will document all |
| 14 | ADA improvements/upgrades. |
| 15 | Technical infeasibility, if any, to meet necessary accessibility compliance shall be |
| 16 | documented and filed as part of the City's records, by the Engineer-of-Record on the |
| 17 | project. |
| 18 | The City shall provide accessibility site audits (inspections) of on-going projects as |
| 19 | part of the project closeout/certification. |
| 20 | Documentation and verification of barrier-mitigation will be integrated into the City's |
| 21 | 2011 Transition Plan on a regular basis to ensure that barriers are "checked-off and |
| 22 | the Plan is current with a record of barrier-mitigation work. |
| 23 | Annual reports of barrier-mitigation work shall be provided to City Council. |
| 24 | Identified in the Transition Plan are proposed facilities barrier-mitigation sorted and |
| 25 | assigned by the following City programs/plans: |

| 1 | Infrastructure Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) FY 2011-2015 (Public Works) |
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| 2 | Department Director) |
| 3 | 2009 Parks Bond Implementation Program (Parks/Trails/Watershed Division) |
| 4 | Director) |
| 5 | BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City shall continue to plan for a biannual |
| 6 | "ADA Transition Planning budget" that will be used to plan mitigation of barriers identified in |
| 7 | the Plan that are not part of any CIP project or Bond program. This budget will be in addition to |
| 8 | and separate from funds required for any ADA improvements and upgrades triggered on account |
| 9 | of CIP projects and Bond Programs. The scope of work and budget for all such CIP and bond |
| 10 | projects must incorporate the improvements triggered by applicable Federal, State and local |
| 11 | accessibility regulations and codes. |
| 12 | BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that maintenance of accessible features is an integral |
| 13 | part of the City's plan to transition into a more accessible destination. The 2011 Transition Plan |
| 14 | includes the following City maintenance programs: |
| 15 | Facilities Maintenance Program (Facilities Maintenance Division Director) |
| 16 | Parking Facilities Operations & Maintenance Program (Parking Division Director) |
