2 **WHEREAS**, the City of Santa Fe needs to be prepared for the strong possibility that the
3 negative national and state economic and financial trends will adversely affect its operations; and

4 **WHEREAS**, because the circumstances and the assumptions upon which the current
5 fiscal year budget has changed and because of the negative national and state economic and
6 financial trends, the Governing Body wants to take immediate and proactive actions to prepare
7 itself for the eventuality and/or the possibility that negative economic and financial trends may
8 adversely affect the City's current fiscal year budget; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the City of Santa Fe wants to ensure that next year's fiscal year budgeting
10 (for fiscal year 09/10) takes into consideration and accounts for the possibility of negative
11 economic and financial trends; and


12 **WHEREAS**, the state of financial and fiscal affairs of all funds at the City of Santa Fe is
13 of such a nature that the Governing Body as a whole has the responsibility to the citizens of Santa
14 Fe to conduct an open and thorough budget review process, whenever circumstances dictate and
15 with as much due diligence and speed as possible.

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**
17 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that the following actions need to be assessed immediately in order to
18 maintain and sustain the efficient operations of government:


- 19 1. All raises (of whatever type or kind) for all permanent bargaining unit, non-
20 bargaining unit, management and part-time employees are hereby **STAYED**.
- 21 2. All vacancies for all full-time positions, which are not related to public safety, are
22 hereby **FROZEN**.
- 23 3. All raises, of whatever type or kind, given in the current fiscal year shall be
24 organized, tabulated, and presented by the City Manager to the Governing Body for
25 possible **RECONSIDERATION AND ABOLISHMENT**.
