11 DIRECTING STAFF TO RESEARCH AND STUDY THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A
12 FAMILY-FRIENDLY "MOVIES IN THE PARK" PROGRAM.

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14 WHEREAS, on September 26, 2007, the governing body adopted Resolution No. 2007-91
15 which established public safety measures for city parks for the safety and security of our citizens; and

16 WHEREAS, in an effort to encourage use of new and improved parks by families in the
17 summertime, the governing body desires to establish a "Movies in the Park" program; and

18 WHEREAS, the mission of "Movies in the Park" would be to foster a sense of community and
19 enjoyment of our many parks by bringing people together to enjoy a movie; and

20 WHEREAS, the city of Santa Fe continues to promote healthy lifestyles for children and
21 their families; and

22 WHEREAS, such a program would create an avenue for Santa Fe families to enjoy summer
23 by using the parks to play and then relaxing and watching a movie.


24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
25 CITY OF SANTA FE that staff is directed to research and study the establishment of a "Movies in

1 the Park" program. Such study shall include, without limitation:

- 2 1. The cost of purchasing the equipment, such as a movie screen and projector;
- 3 2. The annual cost of operating the program;
- 4 3. The parks that could be used for the movies;
- 5 4. Movie selection guidelines; and
- 6 5. A tentative schedule, with date and park location.


7 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that staff is directed to report back to the governing body


