10 A RESOLUTION

11 AMENDING TABLE 37 OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE "IMPACT FEES CAPITAL
12 IMPROVEMENTS PLAN AND LAND USE ASSUMPTIONS, 2007-2012" TO INCLUDE
13 THE RAILYARD PARK AND PLAZA, A REGIONAL PARK, AS AN ELIGIBLE
14 PROJECT TO RECEIVE IMPACT FEE FUNDS.

16 WHEREAS, on January 9, 2008, the Governing Body adopted Resolution No. 2008-7,
17 for the "Impact Fees Capital Improvements Plan and Land Use Assumptions, 2007-2012" for the
18 City of Santa Fe; and


19 WHEREAS, Table 37 of the capital improvements plan includes "Planned Park
20 Improvements, 2007-2012" specifying both the names of neighborhood and regional parks to be
21 eligible for these fees for park improvements, and the estimated amounts required for the
22 improvements for each park; and

23 WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe in partnership with the Trust for Public Land has
24 recently developed the Santa Fe Railyard Park and Plaza, which is a 13-acre regional park in the
25 city's Railyard, for the health and well-being of all of its citizens; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the Railyard Park and Plaza was developed with approximately thirteen
2 million dollars, half of which was raised from private donations from the community at large, and
3 whose completion now faces a funding shortfall.


4 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**
5 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that the Railyard Park and Plaza, a regional park, is added to Page 36,
6 Table 37, "Planned Park Improvements, 2007-2012" of the "Impact Fee Capital Improvements
7 Plan and Land Use Assumptions, 2007-2012" as an eligible project to receive impact fee funds.
