11 **DIRECTING THE CITY OF SANTA FE TRANSIT DIVISION TO PROVIDE FREE**
12 **RIDES ON ALL BUS ROUTES ON ELECTION DAY, NOVEMBER 4, 2008.**

14 **WHEREAS**, county election officials anticipate high voter participation in the
15 November 4, 2008 general elections; and

16 **WHEREAS**, increased use of public transportation will reduce traffic congestion as
17 voters travel to and from polling locations; and

18 **WHEREAS**, free public transportation may ensure transportation to polling locations for
19 citizens who have no other transportation available or who cannot afford regular fares, thereby
20 increasing voter participation; and

21 **WHEREAS**, free public transportation may encourage people to try public transportation
22 thereby promoting its use.


23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**


