

RESOLUTION NO. 2008- 65

A RESOLUTION

SUPPORTING THE EFFORTS OF THE FOOD DEPOT BY EXPANDING THE CURRENT LEASE BY 1.5 ACRES OF CITY PROPERTY ON SILER ROAD FOR EXPANSION OF FOOD BANK ACTIVITIES; AND DIRECTING STAFF TO INCLUDE SUCH AREA IN THE BROWNFIELD STUDY BEING CONDUCTED ON THE ADJACENT 14 ACRE PARCEL THE CITY IS ACQUIRING.

WHEREAS, in 2000, the City of Santa Fe entered into a lease with Kitchen Angels and The Food Depot for 2.125 acres of city land located on Siler Road for the purposes of constructing a facility for the two entities; and

WHEREAS, The Food Depot and Kitchen Angels pay their lease to the City by providing services such as offering emergency food assistance and volunteer opportunities; and

WHEREAS, the Food Depot and Kitchen Angels co-own this facility and rent space to Food for Santa Fe; and

WHEREAS, the Food Depot supplies food to over 100 separate nonprofits for purposes of hunger relief throughout Northern New Mexico, of which 50 nonprofit food programs serve within

1 Santa Fe; and

2 **WHEREAS**, the need for food assistance within the City of Santa Fe and Northern New
3 Mexico continues to expand; and


4 **WHEREAS**, within the current facility, the Food Depot is experiencing storage issues for
5 both dry and cold foods and there is a need to also expand space for Kitchen Angels and Food for
6 Santa Fe; and

7 **WHEREAS**, expanding the lease to include an additional 1.5 acres of City land will allow
8 the construction of an additional building to meet the needs of the occupants.

9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**
10 **CITY OF SANTA FE that** the Governing Body supports and authorizes the expansion of the current
11 lease to include an additional 1.5 acres of City property adjacent to the current property that is leased
12 to the Food Depot and Kitchen Angels.


13 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that City staff is directed to take all necessary measures to
14 ensure that this expansion is effectuated and that all Brownfield studies, to the extent that such are
15 necessary, or required, be conducted in coordination with the efforts that the City is undertaking to
16 acquire a 14 acre parcel adjacent to the current City property.
