

CITY OF SANTA FE, NEW MEXICO RESOLUTION NO. 2008-64

INTRODUCED BY:



REQUESTING THAT THE TRANSIT DIVISION STAFF ESTABLISH A NO-COST BUS PROGRAM THAT WOULD SERVE THE TRANSPORTATION NEEDS OF SANTA FE'S YOUTH, 18 AND UNDER; AND REQUESTING THAT THE MAYOR'S YOUTH ADVISORY BOARD, WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF COMMUNITY SERVICES STAFF AND TRANSIT DIVISION STAFF MODIFY EXISTING ROUTES TO BETTER ACCOMMODATE YOUTH, TAKING INTO CONSIDERATION DESIGNATED STOPS AND APPROPRIATE SCHEDULES.

WHEREAS, there is a need to make the Santa Fe Trails Transit System ("Transit System") more accessible for youth under the age of 18; and

WHEREAS, the 2007-2008 Needs Assessment Report of the Children and Youth

Commission cited transportation as a need for teens who would participate in more Children and

Youth funded activities if they had transportation to and from the programs; and

WHEREAS, with additional Transit System routes and no-cost bus passes, youth could become more involved in Children and Youth funded programs, academic activities, extra

1 curricular activities, sports and employment; and 2 WHEREAS, the rising cost of gasoline makes it difficult for youth to be involved in such 3 programs and activities; and 4 WHEREAS, use of the Transit System would give youth a sense of independence 5 because they wouldn't have to rely on their parents to provide transportation; and 6 WHEREAS, families would save gas, money and time if their youth are using the 7 Transit System; and 8 WHEREAS, by making use of the Transit System as a young person, bus riding could 9 become a lifelong habit as well as an example for other family members to use the Transit 10 System; and 11 WHEREAS, currently the Transit System offers discounted fares for youth between the 12 ages of five through 17 as well as a three month (June, July and August) Y.E.S. (Youth Enjoying 13 Summer) pass for youth between six and 17; and 14 WHEREAS, year round no-cost bus passes would benefit the needs of youth in our 15 community. 16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE 17 CITY OF SANTA FE that the Transit Division staff establish a no-cost bus program that would 18 serve the transit needs of all of Santa Fe's youth, 18 and under. 19 AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor's Youth Advisory Board, with the 20 assistance of Community Services staff and Transit Division staff modify existing routes to better 21 accommodate youth, taking into consideration designated stops and appropriate schedules. 22 AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such recommendations should also include 23 a process, developed by Transit staff, which designates the steps and documentation that would 24 be required in order to obtain a no-cost bus pass. AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the process for adopting such routes and no-25
