11 A RESOLUTION

12 ENCOURAGING THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO TO EVALUATE THE POSSIBILITY  
13 OF PAYING STATE EMPLOYEES LIVING IN THE CITY OF SANTA FE NO LESS  
14 THAN THE CITY OF SANTA FE'S LIVING WAGE.

15 WHEREAS, the cost of living in Santa Fe is higher than most other areas in the state of  
16 New Mexico; and

17 WHEREAS, as the state capital there are many state employees working and living in  
18 the city of Santa Fe; and

19 WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe has adopted the Living Wage Ordinance, requiring a  
20 higher minimum wage than the state's minimum wage for employees working in Santa Fe; and

21 WHEREAS, the City's minimum wage does not apply to the State of New Mexico.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE  
23 CITY OF SANTA FE that the State of New Mexico is encouraged to evaluate the possibility of  
24 paying state employees living in the City of Santa Fe no less than the City of Santa Fe's  
25 minimum wage.
