7	CITY OF SANTA FE that staff is directed to research and recommend to the Governing Body
8	within 120 days an appropriate bike sharing program to be operated out of the bike facility
9	located at the Railyard. During the 120 days staff, working with the Bicycle and Trails Advisory
10	Committee, shall seek community input from other interested stakeholders such as bike related
11	non-profits, bicycle groups, bike shops, and local bicycle industries.
12	AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that staff is directed to work with the Bicycle and
13	Trails Advisory Committee to implement Resolution No. 2007-90 regarding the use of an old
14	railcar or other suitable facility for bicycle storage, information and bike rentals at the Railyard.
