


11 DIRECTING STAFF TO RESEARCH THE POSSIBILITY OF SANTA FE ACHIEVING
12 "BICYCLE FRIENDLY COMMUNITY" STATUS.

14 WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe has made many efforts over the years to encourage the
15 use of bicycles in the community for transportation, recreational and physical fitness related
16 purposes and to maintain the city's air quality, reduce traffic congestion and noise and conserve
17 energy; and

18 WHEREAS, these efforts include but are not limited to: creating the Bicycle and Trails
19 Advisory Committee; funding and building bicycle trails throughout the community; facilitating
20 bicycle connections for Railrunner passengers at the Railyard; participating in Bike to Work
21 Week; installing sharrows aimed to help bicycles and cars share city streets; amending city street
22 standards to require bike lanes; conducting the bicycle safety poster contest for kids; participating
23 in the Santa Fe Metropolitan Planning Organization's bicycle and pedestrian study group whose
24 vision is to designate a network of regionally significant/primary trail corridors and connections;
25 installing bike racks on city buses; and requiring bike racks for new development; and
